E-Education & Digital Jaitpur

There is one certain way to reach the entire nation and talk of “OneIndia”, “Digital India” “Kaushal Bharat” and “Empowered India” and we all are responsible to do our bit for India to come up in the league of developed country.

In today's digital world, computer illiteracy is an overwhelming hindrance to many. Scarcity of computers in rural homes of many states are heard but in reality, it's existing even 50-70 kms from the capital city, Delhi and may lead one to believe that students in these villages have a slim chance at improving their computer skills.

But Sai Social Responsibility & Research Centre in many villages in North India are providing an opportunity to young students to learn and practice on computers, without charging them any fees (except for NIIT Certification Course examination fee).

As a part of “Digital Jaitpur Program” Sai Social Responsibility & Research Centre ensures that weekly classes and tests are conducted where guest resource persons are invited to enrich the experience of the rural students.

Digital Jaitpur is an initiative which aims at educating every child in the district about computers. In each computer centre, there are 6 desktops and 4 laptops, sponsored by Sai Social Responsibility & Research Centre and free training is provided to batches of 20 children each. Students of 6th and 7th standards are given prominence. Maurya Udyog helps us in meeting the ends at rural areas.

"I am very glad to inaugurate this computer literacy program for the benefit of all children residing in the Greater Noida area," he added. Dr. Sushi Singh, Managing Director - Sai Social Responsibility & Research Centre takes this initiative at a personal level and checks periodically on quality, student's confidence and problems while encouraging more of girl child come forward to get free books, and self-defense classes as well.

Dr. Sushi Singh also plans to hold a similar training programme for high school students, with netbooks installed with Internet.



“Nowadays computers have invaded almost all fields; therefore computer literacy assumes paramount importance to people of all walks of life,” She stated. “Teaching computer skills to children in school will motivate them to reach a higher level.”

Over 45 students had already signed up for the free classes. Classes will be conducted in several batches in the evenings during weekdays, and in the daytime on weekends.

Not a single child, adult in the village earlier learnt IT skills and 90 % of them had no basic knowledge of computers.

So, the proud first batch of students selected by Sai Social Responsibility & Research Centre felt empowered and gave interviews thanking Sai Social Responsibility & Research Centre for bringing them to this stage after rigorous practice of 6 months. Sai Social Responsibility & Research Centre's trained girls presented self-defense techniques learnt in past 6 months to exhibit their confidence.

Sai Social Responsibility & Research Centre distributed small tricolor flags to school children and talked to them about how can they celebrate Independence Day in a different way!

- Hang a Tiranga flag from your house roof, car or work building to show respect for it.
- Make a flag/greeting card with patriotic design and colour.

Nari Shakti @ SSRRC/Skill Development phase 1 @ Jaitpur

The rural women daily routine includes cooking, taking care of the family members, cattle rearing and maintaining the household. They do not think independently but are instead dependent on their husband's knowledge or opinions.

SSRRC embarked its journey with a sincere effort to address these challenges by conducting skill development program to the rural women at village Jaitpur, Greater Noida, UP. SSRRC has earlier conducted the short term skill development program "Nari Shakti" where we have imparted six weeks training in tailoring, embroidery, beauty courses in collaboration with our goodwill ambassadors, which was a great success. On great demand of rural women of village Jaitpur, we are planning to open "Garmin Mahila Kaushal Kendra " a women empowerment centre to provide the program for under privileged women of various strata of society .

SAH-Bala - a women empowerment initiative for imparting skills and facilitating a life of dignity and pride.

SSRRC launched a vocational center in Jaitpur village, for imparting skills and facilitating a life of dignity and pride and trained over 80 women about tailoring, candle making, beauty and hair cutting. As first women empowerment program we launched vocational training centre – "Nari Shakti" for village women in collaboration with VLCC .We also conducted four months certification course in beauty and wellness, tailoring and stitching to the rural women of Jaitpur. Some of them started with their own tailoring unit from home and some got connected with neighboring boutiques and hotel for small supplies as napkin etc. SSRRC is truly proud to instill the ability and respect for entrepreneurship amongst women and youth.
