2nd Summer Camp @ Jaitpur

A Sai Social Responsibility & Research Centre (SSRRC) strongly feels that Summer Camps are gateways of children all round development, it took the initiative of organized a 3 week long summer camp in small village of Jaitpur village as a part of its flagship project “Mera Gaon, Meri Jimmedari” in April month of 2018. SSRRC has been ardently involved in the village cluster of Gautam Buddha Nagar of Greater Noida district of Uttar Pradesh in spreading knowledge with the concept of “Learn with Fun”.

In the same effort, this summer (May – June, 2018) SSRRC has come up with an inauguration of Summer Camp for the students from various schools and the village Jaitpur which cannot afford to provide summer camp expense to their students.

All the activities that are planned for these students are created with a double intention of adding that extra element of enjoyment which could not only keep the children meaningfully engaged but also helping them wanting more while learning by DIY(Do It Yourself).

The morning slot of 3 weeks program consisted of

- Spoken English classes were held for helping them with interpersonal skills & learning English as communication medium.
- Students were given an option to choose between different options and go ahead with hobby of their choice – like Mehendi, Dance, Music, and Painting.
- Compulsory computer classes were organized for beginners & advance level to make students having an upper hand in their classes and help them with creating job opportunities.
- Self-defense training was an integral part of girls’ summer camp.
- Second slot was created for women of different ages in which they were provided with – Hindi writing, reading, counting classes, bhajan singing and imparting skills as candle making, potli making and paper bag to empower them with skills and self-esteem and to help their journey towards financial independence under the initiative “Sah-bala” of SSRRC.



SSRRC is working for the holistic development of a child with a special focus on women empowerment also. SSRRC stays determined to let the women, youth and children from marginalized sections of the society understand the meaning of empowerment as-‘ to live every minute with love, grace and gratitude’.
